### FEEDBACK COMMITTEE REPORT 2021-22

Rajiv Gandhi Mahavidyalaya, Mudkhed implemented the programme of teacher, course, library, and college evaluation every year. Under 'Rajiv Gandhi Quality Enhancement Program' different questionnaires were provided by Rajiv Gandhi Mahavidyalaya to BA, BSc and B.Com students to realize their expectations from Mahavidyalaya and the teachers to know students intentions and aspirations regarding the course they have studied. In questionnaires regarding student is to understand ability and command of teachers over the subject and in questionnaires of evaluation of college by students is to know their opinions about college.

The feedback committee has given the forms to student, teacher, HODs, parents and alumni and all members submitted to the proforma in March. It's detailed analysis is given in the report of statistical format. Overall, the committee gave seven types of proforma. These forms are analyzed as follows.

#### 1. Programme feedback

The Feedback Committee collected data by asking various questions in the proforma. In response to the questions of 4 Points of scale that's 1. Below threshold, 2- Satisfactory, 3- Good, 4- Very good. This form is related to specific subjects and courses in Arts and Science. The course evaluation using four-point scale is given as follows.

At the time of analysis, the first rating was 68. 83% and it was grown up to 71 .47 %. From course second to forth, the rating was same . In the fifth course overall rating was increased from 71.47 to 76. 76% in Science faculty course first to fourth the rate was increased that is 76.76

## 2. Student Feedback of Teacher

The survey was also based on students' feedback for teachers. This form was filled by students. This form is about evaluation about specific subject teacher by using the four- point scale parameter. that is 1- Below threshold, 2- Satisfactory, 3-Good, 4-Very good the feedback committed to 10 copies of these forms from student for every teacher. The committee randomly takes eleven teachers forms submitted by students on the basis of thirty evolution parameters . 81% teachers are in very good rank, whereas 19% are in good ranked.

## 3. Overall rating of program of study

The third feedback form was based on overall rating of program of study. This form was filled by final year students and submitted to Feedback Committee after



the final examination result. This questionnaire contained fifteen parameters and response of the students evaluated. The study programme on the basis of given fifteen parameters was done by using four-point scale. The feedback form was randomly selected from students of art, science and commerce faculty respectively.

As per the above divided circle diagram, it seems that out of 360 in diagram highest percentage of (132) optioned by very good and its scale indicates that respondent students were very happy with the course. The chose 96 students who feel good with the program in which they studied. 72 students found satisfactory with the programme. Only 60 students recorded their evaluation as below threshold that is only due to lack of hostel facility to the students.

#### **4. Exit Questionnaire for Graduation Students: -**

The fourth feedback form was about Exit Questionnaire for graduating students. 86% students planned to do M. A. , M. Sc. and M.Com after the completion of the programme. 80% students opinioned that postgraduate education is most valuable and useful addition education in future. All the students gave the grace to their opinion about the ideal teacher. Usually, the students give the grace to their own subject teacher. Almost the student's response has positively for advice. Most of the students responses are positive about their personality after coming this college. The college helped to them to build up their personality. 100% students agree with friendship with the faculty members. They are mentally intermingled with one another.

#### **5. Entry Questionnaires for Students**

the fifth feedback form was entry questionnaire for students. In response to the questions of taking admission in the particular courses, 80% students answered why they took admission in the course to gain useful knowledge and skill. 90% students believed that the opted course is challenging. They are of the opinion that reputation of all teachers depends on the style of teaching. 80% students believed that their teachers are friendly in attitude. Easy grading, providing intellectual stimulations and educational atmosphere are disciplined. 90% students say that college time is convenient.

#### **6. Alumni feedback form: -**

the sixth feedback form was about Alumni feedback taken from alumni of the college. Alumni occupied positions like police, teacher, PSI and Coaching Institute



Director, peon, clerk, advocate etc. 100% Alumni were interested to visit this college whenever the college called them. Some Alumni says that the college has to increase sports facility.

#### 7. Feedback form for parents :-

The seventh feedback form was about parents. 100% parents gave priority to the college and 40% parents opinioned that the facilities in the college are advocate. 90% parents were satisfied and 80% their satisfied for cooperation from an administrative staff. 90% parents communication with teaching staff was very good and 90% parents informed that their children must be taught soft and hard skills. 70% parents say that their wards are interested in sports. 60% parents have appreciated that their wards get books from the library. 100% believed that monthly test and per semester exam enrich their wards learning capacity. 80% presents say that college time table is executed properly.
