

The society has kept its educational graph rising for the decades. It expanded into many schools and colleges. The society always looked forward for upgrading the educational facilities so as to keep itself prompt with the changes in rural and urban areas. This contribution was recognized as awards, 'Dalit Mitra Puraskar' and 'Rajya Puraskar' to the Society from the state Govt. of Maharashtra.

Shri Sharda Bhavan Education Society's Rajiv Gandhi Mahavidyalaya, Mudhked was established in 2001 and it runs Arts, Science, Commerce Faculties with college goal 'to attain academic excellence, motivate for research, develop the personality of students and provide them an opportunity for employability.'

### **College Facilities:**

## 1) Laboratory:

The college has spacious and well-equipped laboratories for all the science subjects.

#### 2) Library:

Library services at Rajiv Gandhi Mahavidyalaya are the cornerstone of its education system and building with enormous space. The library has more than 6000 books and 6 Journals. The Library is provided with internet broadband facility through wire line & Wi-Fi at free of cost. Library is open during 9:00 am to 5:00 pm. We make every effort to provide practical assistance to any student with disability. Advances in providing electronic access to many of our resources of campus have increased the support to library members.



# Library rules to be followed by the students:

- i) Every student can get two books on his Library card every week. If the student does not return the book within a given time, he will be charged a fine of Rs. 2 per day.
- ii) If a student loses the book or tears the pages of the book, he will have to pay ten times the price of the book.
- iii) Depending upon availability, the student will be issued 2 to 4 books of their concerned course, which are to be resumed before commencement of the annual examination.
- iv) It is the duty of all the students to abide strictly by the instructions given from time to time by the librarian. The librarian will have an authority to get back books issued to the students.
- v) Students, seeking re-admission, will have to renew their library cards at the commencement of the academic year.

# 3) National Service Scheme (NSS) Unit:

NSS unit plays an important role in personality development of the student. The NSS unit volunteers have to remain in NSS unit activities for two years. During the period they have to work for minimum 240 hours and attend a special camp of 7 days. The volunteers obtaining University certificates are eligible to secure 5 marks in the final year of their graduation. In every academic year 50 students (both boys and girls) are enrolled in the NSS and NSS unit organizes an annual special camp of 7 days.

# 4) Sports Activities:

The college has been providing very good sports environment to enhance sportsmanship in students, which is very important in confidence building, to maintain good physical strength and overall personality development. Many students have participated in number of University, inter-tlniversity, State level and National level tournaments in almost all types of events.

#### 5) Cultural Activities:

Students are motivated to participate in all types of competitions at college, University and State level, in dance, music, etc. The literary competitions in Marathi, Hindi and English are conducted at college level through Dnyanteetrh (Marathi), Sanjot (Hindi) and Wisdom (English) literary associations.

#### **ADMISSION AND ELIGIBILITY:**

- 1) An application for admission to the college will have to be made on a printed application form by all students (including those who were studying in this College in the previous year).
- 2) It should be noted that the payment of the fees by itself does not confirm admission to the college, if admission is not granted. (With deduction as per the rules in that behalf)
- 3) The admission is valid if the student pays the prescribed fees on the day the authorities sign the admission form.
- 4) The students who wish to avail themselves of the government concession for fees under the scheme for economically backward class, should fill up the prescribed form within one week from the date of admission as per the rules and attach the relevant income certificates as per the rules. The application forms are available in the college office.

#### The following documents are required for admission:

- i) Original Marks sheet (4 Xerox Copies)
- ii) An attested photo copy of the marks sheet. (4 Xerox Copies)
- iii) Aadhar Card (4 Xerox Copies)
- iv) Transfer Certificate (4 Xerox Copies)
- v) Caste certificate (if applicable) (4 Xerox Copies)
- vi) ABC ID of the student (2 Xerox Copes)
- vii) Eligibility Form (Only for FY)
- 5) A Student coming from any college affiliated to the S.R.T.M.U. Nanded and applying for S.Y. B.A. / B.Sc. / B.Com. class can be directly admitted to this college, Provided that the seats are available. He / She will have to apply to the previous college for a Transfer certificate after joining the college.
- 6) A Student coming from a university other than S.R.T.M.U. Nanded for S.Y. B.A. / T.Y. B.A. or S.Y. / T.Y. B.Sc. will have to submit the required certificate with the duly filled up Eligibility application form to the college office.
- 7) A Student seeking admission to any class of this college shall bring two passport size photo at the time of payment of fees.

#### **Eligibility Certificate:**

A student migrating from other Universities / Boards either from the State of Maharashtra will be admitted to the college on production of an Eligibility certificate (or a provisional admission certificate, pending issue of the final eligibility certificate) from the university of S.R.T.M.U. Nanded.

For this purpose the student will have to apply to the S.R.T.M.U. Nanded in the prescribed form of the eligibility certificate along with the original (and a Xerox copy there of): 1) Passing certificate 2) Statement of marks and 3) Migration certificate from the previous University / Board; and a) Attendance b) Character certificate and c) Transfer certificate from the Principal of the previous college. The students have to pay the eligibility certificate fees.

The responsibility of obtaining an eligibility certificate from the S.R.T.M. University lies with the students themselves.



### **Reservation for Admission:**

- For Scheduled Caste and Scheduled caste converted to Buddhism 13%, for Scheduled Tribes 7% for VJ 3%, tor Nomadic Tribes (NT-1) 2.5%, Nomadic Tribes (NT-2) 3.5%, Nomadic Tribes (N.T-3) 2%, Other Backward Class 19%, Special Backward class 2%, ESBC 16%.
- 2. Admission of 2% in respected category can be given to the wards of freedom fighter, wards of defense servicemen, defense ex-servicemen, wards of project affected parents and 3% admission in respected category to disabled students having certificate of 40% disabled from civil surgeon.

#### **General Instructions:**

- i Students belonging to the category N.T., O.B.C., ESBC & S.B.C. section of Reservation for Admission will have to produce certificate of "Not belonging to creamy layer" as specified by the Government to avail the facility of reservation. Except the caste certificate, no other document will be considered for reservation in admissions.
- ii Admission sought on the basis of false document will be cancelled at any time and action will be taken against such students.
- iii Every admission form should bear a passport size photograph.
- iv While leaving the college, students will have to pay Rs.50/- fees to get T.C.

#### About Fees, Cancellation of Admission and Refund of fees

- i Student will have to pay the fees prescribed by the College/University from time to time and take receipts from the office.
- ii For every education programme, the University has prescribed the fees. Till further instructions are received, the fee structure would remain unchanged for the same academic year.
- iii If the student, who is declared to be in first or second merit list cancels his/her admission, 10% of the amount from their fees will be deducted. To get the fee refunded, it is necessary to get admission cancelled before July.
- iv Those students who have taken admission to Non-Granted/Permanent Non-Granted course, their fees will not be refunded later on even if the student gets seat in granted quota of same subject or other subject.
- v Those students who have transferred their admission from non-granted / permanent non-granted course to granted course, will have to pay the fees as per the structure of course.
- vi 1) Students can apply for the cancellation of their admission within 15 days of the beginning of the academic year. They should apply for the concerned / management / academic wing in University. 10% of the college fee and practical fee will be deducted as administrative fee.
  - 2) If the student apply for the cancellation within 30 days, 25% fee would be deducted.
  - 3) After 30 days fees would not be refunded.
- vii All the rules and regulations remain under S.R.T.M.U., Nanded norms from time to time.

#### **Examination - Rules and Regulations**

# First Year & Second Year (B.A./B.Sc./B.Com.)

The university has adopted NEP 2020 semseter system of examinations. For BA It includes 40 marks for theory, 10 marks for internal college performance.

For B.Sc. it includes  $40\,\text{marks}$  for theory,  $10\,\text{marks}$  for internal college performance.

For B.Com. it includes  $80\,\text{marks}$  for theory,  $20\,\text{marks}$  internal practice.

SEC is as per S.R.T.M. University, Nanded norms.

# Third Year (B.A./B.Sc./B.Com.)

For B.A. / B.Com / B.Sc. III, the Exam Pattern involves 50 marks Internal Evaluation by the college and 25 marks Semester Examination conducted by the university.

For B.A. III Geography, there is a Practical Paper of  $100\,\mathrm{marks}$  at the end of Sem VI.

For B.Sc III, there are two practical papers of 50 marks each for each science paper at the end of Sem VI.

For B.Com III, there is a project of 100 marks at the end of Sem VI.

SEC is as per S.R.T.M. University, Nanded norms.



#### Attendance and Discipline:

- 1) The students are advised to read regularly all notices displayed on the notice boards at various places. ignorance of the same can not be justified.
- A student must always carry on his / her I-card the same must be produced on demand by any college authority.
- The student shall attend lectures, practical, tutorials, unit tests and examinations and shall keep their guardians informed of their studies.
- 4) The college uniform is compulsory.
- 5) The student should note that they will not be permitted to appear for the University Examination if they fail to satisfy the college authorities on any of the following grounds:
  - a) At least 75% attendance at lectures / practical.
  - b) At least 75% attendance at N.S.S. work as prescribed.
  - c) Attendance and performance at the college examination Tutorials.
  - d) Good and disciplined behavior in the college campus.
  - e) Obedient to the instructions of teachers, staff and any college authorities.
  - f) Payment of fees as instructed.

#### **RULES OF DISCIPLINE**

- The students must observe strict discipline in the college campus and should not disturb the college/teaching staff & administration in any manner whatsoever.
- 2) The students should take proper care of the college property and help in keeping the premises clean, neat and tidy. Any damage will be treated as a serious breach of discipline and the cost of the damage will be recovered from the students.
- 3) The students in the college shall form no Society or Association and no person should be invited to attend and address any meeting without the prior permission of the principal.
- 4) The students should be regular and punctual in attending their lectures, practical, tutorials and tests. Student should refrain from remaining absent, however, if a student desire to remain absent for any genuine reason, prior permission of the principal should be taken.
- 5) The students should not loiter about and sit near class rooms, laboratories, in verandas, stair case, cycle stand and play ground, that may cause disturbance to the periods / classes which are going on. They should either go to the library or leave the college premises, in case there are no lectures or practical.
- Smoking, chewing tobacco, use of drugs or these type of activities are strictly prohibited in the college campus.
- The students must deactivate mobile phones in the classrooms and laboratories or during any academic activity.
- 8) Annual Social Gathering and any similar programs / functions, which are likely to disrupt to academic atmosphere in the college campus, shall not be permitted.
- 9) The students should not take part in any kind of ragging menace.
