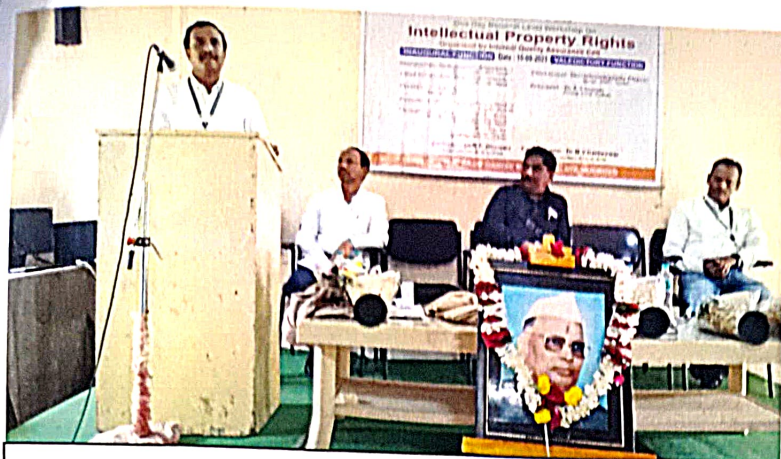
Inaugural Function:

Topic: IPR: An Introduction to Copyright

The topic of his presentation was **IPR: An Introduction to Copyright**. He elaborated on its historical background, legal provisions, fair use policies, and its importance in academia and publishing.
